Boat Options

Completed Boat without GPS Unit: Add 8 to 10 cups of sand and fiberglass resin to ballast the keel, epoxy the mast and keel into their slots, and rig the sail. Note: This does not include the sand or fiberglass resin, or the GPS unit. **\$1,500**

GPS Options

We use two different GPS units according to your needs. To ensure you get the right unit, we suggest you call Brad Janocha at (302) 540-0238.

Global Star GPS Unit: We have used this unit for years. It is reliable but limited. It covers the North Atlantic but is limited in other oceans. This unit has to be programmed by us to report its position at certain times each day. Once the frequency is set it cannot be changed. This unit only has one-way communication and only reports its position. We use this to study winds and currents. It will not support sensors for additional research. **\$600**

Iridium GPS Unit: This unit has several important advantages. It gives complete worldwide coverage and allows two-way communication with your boat. You can send data from onboard sensors to your computer allowing real time research. You can also change the frequency you receive position reports which means as your boat approaches shore you can make it report more frequently so you'll have a much easier time locating & recovering your. **\$800**
